How to Generate a Security Token for Salesforce

Note: Personal access tokens are used to log in to Exalate for Salesforce.

Once Exalate has been configured and verified, you need the following data to log in:

- **Username** - issue tracker administrator user
- **Password** - consists of the issue tracker password and security token, without spaces




You can reset the security token from your Salesforce account.

1. Log in to your Salesforce account.

The Salesforce user must be an organization member or have admin access to a repository where Exalate is installed.

2. Click the profile avatar and choose **Settings**.



3. Select **My Personal Information** → **Reset My Security Token**.

Reset Security Token

When you access Salesforce from an IP address that isn't trusted for your company, and you use a desktop client or the API, you need a security token to log in. What's a security token? It's a case-sensitive alphanumeric code that's tied to your password. Whenever your password is reset, your security token is also reset.

 After you reset your token, you can't use your old token in API applications and desktop clients.
