

# How to Set a Default Epic on the Destination Side in Jira On-premise

This article shows how to set a default epic on the Destination side.

## Introduction

You can set a default epic for all issues received from the other side. With the help of [Exalate external scripts library](#) this can be done with one single line of code in your Sync Rules.

## Source Side

The Source side does not need to send some specific data. You don't need to add any new code to the Data filter here.

## Destination Side

1. Upload the [DefaultEpic.groovy](#) file to the **\$JIRA\_HOME/scripts** directory.
2. Add the code below to the **Incoming sync(Create and Change processor)**

```
DefaultEpic.setEpic(issue, "Service") // replace 'Service' with the relevant Epic Name
```
